

IDEOLOGY AND CULTURE. TECHNIQUES OF TOTALITARIAN RHETORICS. CONSEQUENCES ON LANGUAGE AND THINKING

Rezumat: *Ideologies become totalitarian and are separated from any real experience. They are anti-cultural by definition. To live religiously its adhesion to a totalitarian ideology does not mean that certain ideology is a religion. Separating the individual psychic apparatus from a collective representation system (language, myths, tradition, divinities) produces a type of isolation. From here to the bureaucracy of crime ("evil's banality") the distance is negligible.*
