

HATRED AS AN HERITAGE

Rezumat: *In 1870, Mihai Eminescu wrote his wonderful fairy-tale: "Prince-Charming Born out Of a Tear". There was little surprise to me when, reciting the story, I (re) discovered the phrase: "He felt weak, he was dying and had no son to whom to leave his heritage of hatred...His neighbor had died and left the legacy of hatred and blood feud to his children."*

In 1914, Sigmund Freud wrote in "On Narcissism": "The individual leads, in fact, a double existence: as an aim in itself and as an element in a chain to which he is subjected against his own will or, at any rate, without his wishing..."

I tried to capture a character's destiny and the destiny of an idea, who share a powerful connection: the legacy. And I used this generous source of inspiration to understand the experience of patients with psychotic parents.
