

HATE AND THE STAKES OF FILIATION

Rezumat: *In a family, when the symbolic events unbalance the transmission processes, the traumatic filiation is first and at the same time some sort of an incestuous violence against the difference. In this context, children's adolescence is a moment when hate towards relationships can be highly exacerbated. Thus, these teenagers often find themselves in situations of fratricidal violence of self-provocation, self-sabotage and paradoxical functioning, at the same time putting into practice powerful traumatophilic tendencies. It seems that we may find the same processes at the level of groups, institutions and even the existence of denegation pacts that harden the evolution of the ensemble and lead to violence against the transmission from generation to generation.*
