

THE NARCISSIST THREAT AND HATE IN ANOREXIA RELATED PROBLEMATICS

Rezumat: *By means of two clinical observation sheets, we intend to identify the figures of object hate and self-hate that appear in the problematics of anorexia, when the disorder brought about by puberty turns the body into a foreign object. Initially, the relation of hate stemmed from "the self's fight for preservation and assertion" (Freud). Paradoxically, the hate participating in attacking the object and the self can also represent a way of salvation. Can turning hate into body hate be considered a way of salvation? We will try to approach the multiple variants, sometimes dangerous, of these contradictions, taking into account that in adolescence the wound caused by the fundamental dependence of the little being re-emerges.*
