

ADOLESCENCE AND INSTITUTIONAL HATE: ABOUT INSTITUTIONS

Rezumat: *The author briefly discusses the question of silence regarding the hospitalized adolescents. Silence makes possible for the adolescent to perceive his/her own sufferings but also to build him/herself. In silence, hate becomes apparent, and the adolescent's love for noisy situations is explicable through the opportunity it gives to unconsciously evacuate the hate. The author raises the issue of the psychoanalyst's silence during the first interviews with adolescents, reflecting on it in connection with the hate feelings.*
